4.5 COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT IN THE DESIGN OF FOGO SERVICE - CURRENT STATUS AND ISSUES

In parallel with the bin audit, it was decided that the Committee would start engaging with the community on a future FOGO collection service, adapting materials from other local councils as appropriate. Also, as part of this engagement, the Committee would as a first step establish focus groups seeking participants from existing community, environment and business organisations in Yass Valley.
