Crago Mill Precinct

Summary

During the reporting period, several key developments occurred within the project.

This Project Control Group (PCG) Report documents the progress made during the period of 28 June to 31 July 2025 for the Yass valley Council (YVC) Civic Precinct Project (the Project).

Construction is progressing well. Flooring and joinery installation is continuing in the Library, with final painting and services fit off nearing completion.

The administration building roof is being finalised with services window installation being undertaken. Landscaping, ramps and external pathways are continuing to be installed despite weather delays.

Crago Mill structural design cost is under review as subsequent adaptations were made to incorporate the current building structural issues.

Construction Certificate planning of the commercial building is underway, with lodgement expected to occur in the next reporting period.

The Onerwal Aboriginal Land Council and first nations participants are continuing to make progress towards room naming and glazing artwork designs. An expression of interest is to be sent out for Ngunnawal artists to commission the art pieces. A recent grant submission has been made to assist with costs.

The main Crago Mill precinct sign design has been completed. Appropriate height placement and materials to complement the precinct design intent has been incorporated.

Removalist procurement submissions are currently under review by the Evaluation Committee, with a contract anticipated to be awarded mid-August.

Council Change Champions met this month to discuss new ways of working, space use and principles that could apply to the new facilities. Upcoming change champions sessions will target move readiness and relocation practices.

The current program indicates a delay of 9 weeks from the originally contracted Contractor program. Project team analysis of the program indicates a forecasted Practical Completion date within mid-October 2025, consistent with previous reporting.



2. Progress

2.1. Design

The following construction activities have been reported for this month and forecast for the next reporting period.

2.2. Procurement

The Contractor has local and indigenous procurement targets which it is required to achieve on this project and will be reporting back to the project team at monthly intervals. As of the end of July 2025 indigenous procurement is sitting at 26% of total labour spend to date.

Local industry participation is being actively managed on the project and achievement of target spend profiles is a key measure of project success. Latest local procurement spending is tracking as follows:

- Category 1 procurement (within 100kms of site excluding Canberra), is tracking at 40.86% verses 50% target.
- Category 2 procurement (within 200kms of site including Canberra), is tracking at 54.53% verses 80% target.

2.3. Decanting and Relocations

Removalist procurement commenced this period. 5 local Contractors, targeted for Library experience, were invited to a site briefing where scope of works was presented coupled with a walk through of current facilities.

Four contractors provided a submission for consideration. These are currently under review by the Evaluation Committee, with a Contract anticipated to be awarded mid-August.

 to essential services will be planned with notice provided to affected stakeholders.


Figure 2 Aerial View of Administration
