REPORT

1. Report

The Yass Pool Redevelopment Project Committee at its meeting held on 17 July 2025 suggested that further pricing be sought from aquatic engineers to review the options of a heated pool with upgrades to the existing 50m pool. The options include:

- Refurbish 50m pool to include accessibility ramp into pool include Myrtha Pools technology or equivalent and
- Option to enclose the existing 50m pool to create a 50m indoor heated pool or
- Option to enclose 25m of the existing 50m pool to create a 25m heated pool with overhead structure or
- Construct a new 25m x 6 lane indoor heated pool include Myrtha Pools technology or equivalent (location TBC).

Quotes to include OPC (Opinion Probable Cost) for each option.

Council undertook request for quotations for a review of the above options with the amount being circa \$25,000. The amount exceeds the allocated funding of \$20,000. An option to consider could be to reduce the scope of works requested from the preferred aquatic engineer to exclude:

- Option 1– Enclosing the existing 50m pool and/or
- Option 2 Enclosing 25m of the existing 50m pool

This may bring the cost of the review to within the current allocated budget for the pool redevelopment project.
